#### A Word from Liberty

I was reading in multi-versions in my Bible program (*The Message, The Amplified Bible, and the NIV*) and this following passage caught my eye in Peterson's version of the Bible, *The Message*. This version can be so direct, so real, and so "street Greek" understandable as he calls it. In Romans 8:1-3;

*"1 Those who enter into Christ's being-here-for-us no longer have to live under a continuous, low-lying black cloud. 2 A new power is in operation. The Spirit of life in Christ, like a strong wind, has magnificently cleared the air, freeing you from a fated lifetime of brutal tyranny at the hands of sin and death. 3 God went for the jugular when he sent his own Son. He didn't deal with the problem as something remote and unimportant. In his Son, Jesus, he personally took on the human condition, entered the disordered mess of struggling humanity in order to set it right once and for all. The law code, weakened as it always was by fractured human nature, could never have done that. The law always ended up being used as a Band-Aid on sin instead of a deep healing of it" (The Message).*

Since the last newsletter in June, this has been two long months of exciting planning, scrambling, and then regrouping. The saying, **Man proposes, but God disposes**, is so true.



Because of student Paula Pierce from the June LSM Teachers' School, I will be in St. Petersburg FL speaking September 8-10, 2006. Because of Cheryl Weeks and her little band of Aussies from the February LSM Teachers' School, I will be in Australia in May 2007. Because of another student, I may be in North Carolina in October. I had no idea of any of this earlier this year. There is an absolute beauty to praying with the Keys of the Kingdom to strip your soul of its plans and agendas so that you might move into God's plans. His ways are higher!

There is a most interesting truth that can be found in Jeremiah 44:16-18, particularly in *The Message* version of Scriptures: *"We're having nothing to do with what you tell us is GOD's Message. We're going to go right on offering sacrifices to the Queen of Heaven and pouring out drink offerings to her, keeping up the traditions set by our ancestors, our kings and government leaders in the cities of Judah and the streets of Jerusalem in the good old days. We had a good life then—lots of food, rising standard of living, and no bad luck. But the moment we quit sacrificing to the Queen of Heaven and pouring out offerings to her, everything fell apart. We've had nothing but massacres and starvation ever since."*

Their thinking was backwards. Rather than listening to the Prophet Jeremiah and doing something about what God was telling them, they instead blamed God for their hard circumstances. The bad things that were happening to them were consequences of their own wrong choices, not (as they thought) because they stopped doing what they wanted in sacrificing to the "Queen of Heaven."

I address another kind of backwards thinking in **BEYOND Shattered Strongholds**. We often get calls and e-mails from brand new readers in a full blown state of panic or anger. Because they have begun to pray with the Keys of the Kingdom and their walls and old foundations are crumbling and falling, they are convinced that these prayer keys are not of God and are ready to blame the prayers. They want to return to their own ways of doing things instead of seeking God's ways and His will. This is when both their unsundered souls and Satan are thinking, "Gotcha! Now get back in line with the stronghold thinking, deception and denial that we taught you to use, even if it only works temporarily."

We tell them, “Don’t stop praying the prayers, or your soul will regroup and launch its storm trooper construction crews to take over again. Those rascals will immediately begin to reconstruct your walls of self defense, self-deception, and self-denial!”

Why do these prayers cause so much shaking and rocking in the lives of those who pray them? Soul restoration is much like urban renewal, the cleaning up and restoring of the inner city that has gotten seedy, dirty, even dangerous. Many dangerous old buildings may only come down with a wrecking ball and dynamite. This makes rubble everywhere. So the dump trucks come in and big front-end loaders are fired up to scoop up the rubble and dump

it into the trucks which take it away.

The renewal process in your own soul is like that. Big chunks of soulish concrete mind sets, soulish chain-link thinking, and the soulish brick stronghold walls have to be demolished and coughed up to make room for divine renewal to begin. Renovation and restoration has to begin at ground zero.

Sometimes coughing up these chunks of junk out of your soul can be like a poor cat trying to hawk up the biggest hairball of its life. There’s going to be wheezing, sneezing, choking, and more coughing before it’s all over. Remember this, however: a cleared lot in the slums can be the beginning of a beautiful new building. A cleared soul can hold more of God’s goodness and grace than one that is full of hairballs. (How’s that for mixed metaphors!)

#### **DVD Long-Distance Training of LSM Teachers!**

We’re still in the process of trying to locate the perfect venue for the filming of our Long-Distance Teachers’ Training DVDs. We may be moving the project out of the Sacramento area which will increase our costs, but will provide an enhanced atmosphere for the finished DVDs. In working with venues, scripts, voiceovers, theme songs, and video crews, I feel sort of like a video financial advisor, script writer, producer, director, gaffer, gofer, and leading lady all rolled into one as we are trying to move in God’s timing for this to be accomplished.

We are now hoping to have everything in place by January or February 2007. We feel this project is too important to force it into a back-up venue with inadequate funds. We are still asking if some of you would help us with the funding for this project. There are no salaries involved in budget, just over head, filming crews, new DVD duplicators and disk imprinters, and the DVD master production costs. There is still no charge for

attending this one-time teaching of 16 subjects. This same teaching in a certification school setting in our training center in Sacramento is \$200.00. Here are the subjects:

- **09 RELATIONSHIPS**
- **10 UNDERSTANDING SOUL POWER AND SOULISH PRAYERS**

#### Perhaps You're Only **ONE QUARTER OF AN INCH** Away From God's Greatest Plans for Your Life

As a Christian, you should never be intimidated or discouraged because things haven't turned out the way you hoped. Perhaps you have been off just **ONE QUARTER OF AN INCH** in your attempts to cooperate with God's plan for your life. Once you let God adjust you by just **ONE QUARTER OF AN INCH**, you can walk right into your destiny path. Think about this excerpt from Dr. Robert Schuller's *Everybody Makes Mistakes*.

- Every artist messes up a canvas at one time
- Every accountant uses a pencil with an eraser.
- Every writer has used the delete key over and over
- Every designer has thrown away finished designs and started over
- Every cook has burned a batch of cookies.

These people are not failures. The person who **never makes a mistake** is the person who is the biggest failure. This is a person who has never tried to do something outside of his or her comfort zone, has never tried to step beyond the boundaries, has never dared to try something new. Foolishness, laziness, and lack of caring can cause mistakes, but you can change those attitudes. Your biggest and best mistakes (made with good intentions) prove you are not a total failure because:

- You did not fail to make a choice
- You did not fail to commit to something new
- You did not fail to try something you weren't sure you could do
- You did not fail to attempt something outside of your daily routine
- You did not fail in the courage it takes to try to grow and change

Choose to commit to having the courage to make a mistake and then learn from your mistakes! Let the Lord help you to turn them from stumbling blocks into stepping stones with Christ's help.

#### Liberty Savard Writers' School in Sacramento CA (Red Lion Inn) - September 19-22, 2007

I've just returned from an excellent Christian writer's conference in Pittsburgh PA, put on by Marlene Bagnull's ministry, Write His Answer. It was great being with other Christian writers, and I feasted on teachings there such as writing Christian fiction for children and for adults, script writing, and character development. I loved hearing about the process of developing characters for fiction—actually creating a person with a history, with personality quirks, with dreams, and then revealing the character's traits and quirks through their own words, actions, and reactions. We will be having the first Liberty Savard Writers' Conference in Sacramento in September of 2007. For years, I have been asked to mentor new writers and to critique first manuscripts. **God's Gray Areas – Inspired By (and partially edited from )Article of the Same Name on CBN.com by Julie Ferwerda—Read her full article there.**

I (Liberty) receive e-mails and letters from Christian men and women nearly every day who are living in painful situations with abusive, lying, unfaithful, addicted spouses. These believers are torn between "hanging in there" and watching their children's lives falling apart before their eyes, seeing their family sink into debt, and feeling lost themselves. It can be very difficult for those "hanging on" to know what God really wants them to do in such destructive circumstances.

I advise these people to put their faith in what God wants them to do now instead of just blindly staying in these situations only to see their families lives ruined because "God hates divorce." He does hate divorce, but He also hates seeing spouses and children destroyed. When situations have deteriorated to brokenness, destitution, and desperation, I advise Christian spouses to pray for the erring spouse and then release him or her to God.

Then I advise them to focus their prayers and their plans on their children and themselves. God can sometimes deal with an abusive spouse better when he or she is no longer the focus of the entire situation. There are times when the believing spouse needs to remove him- or herself from the situation (not always meaning divorce) so as to focus on finding a healing solution for everyone's sake.

Jesus didn't specifically address these kinds of circumstances. But where is the glory for God when men and women are stripped of identity and purpose and their children live with lifetime scars (physical, mental, and emotional) and deep insecurities? You can drive yourself crazy trying to apply all the methods, read all the books, and go through all the counseling; and still end up not being able to change your spouse. That is because Jesus is the only One who can bring about real inner heart/soul change in a damaged, addicted, hurting man or woman who only knows how to lash out at others and use them.

Should a spouse and children stay in that kind of a household, accepting the addiction and abuse? How long should they endure the behaviors that go along with it

such as lying; stealing; spending too much money; emotional, verbal, and/or physical abuse; sexual misconduct; unfaithfulness; neglect; betrayal; contempt, lack of respect? How long should they choose to stay on a path that is making the whole family sick at heart?

In Leviticus 19, we read *do not cut your sideburns* and we read *do not practice witchcraft*. One doesn't apply today, but the other obviously still does. It can be difficult for people in desperate circumstance to find their way to hearing from God so as to know which Scripture applies to them and which one might not mean what they think it means. So how do we know what to do when the Bible is not really clear about dangerous, complex emotional issues rumbling and boiling all around us and our families? Jesus answered the Pharisees' question about which commandment of God was the most important (they were hoping to test Him) in Matthew 22:37-40:

---

***“Jesus replied: “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ THIS IS THE FIRST AND GREATEST COMMANDMENT. And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.”***

---

When dealing with relational gray areas, ask yourself first: “Will this thing I am contemplating, I am already doing, or that I want to do help me to know God better and to **love Him with all my heart**, or will it compromise my relationship with Him somehow?” Once you have satisfied that question, then you ask yourself if your response to a given situation is shaped out of your love for you family member, your friend, or your neighbor, loving them the same as you love yourself.

Julie Ferwerda rightfully then wrote that application of Scripture should always follow that order—devotion and love to God first, love for people second. If holding on to another person **is preventing you from obeying the first command of loving God with all your heart**, then you must obey the first command. This is easier to determine correctly when you are praying with the binding and loosing prayers, particularly loosing self-agendas, self-motives, and soulish desires. Jesus always put love for God first and then the people above the rules of His day. Every situation may be different, but the underlying motive—love in its proper order—is the same.

Julie Ferwerda also wrote that one person living with an abuser or an addict may be thriving and still able to grow in his or her love relationship **with God** in spite of the oppressive situation in the home. Another person may be so mistreated, controlled, and beaten down that he or she can only think “survival.” One may be able to stay while

the other may need a safe place to become whole and restore God to His rightful place in his or her life.

Julie has given us an excellent guideline here to apply to our more difficult, even gray, relationship issues. Enhance this guideline with prayer, reading and meditating upon the Word, and fellowship with the body of Christ. God wants to guide you through complex relationship issues that are not clearly defined in the Bible, yet are visible in the order of the love of the Living Word himself.

#### Questions and Answers by Liberty

---

**QUESTION:** My wife and I are remodeling our house, and a designer has been mentoring us in this venture. Recently I have felt that there has been an emotional soul tie forming between this woman and myself. She comes by almost every day where she finds things to do for us. I find myself thinking about her more than I like. My wife has also commented that she feels there is something not quite right with this woman's attention to me. I have prayed for this to be broken a number of times, but it just won't go away. What should I do? Wayne

**ANSWER:** Wayne, if you are praying the Breaking Soul Ties prayers from either of my two books, **Breaking the Power** or **Producing the Promise**, and find that you are still not getting any relief, then you probably don't really want this broken. A strong, positive declaration of faith in your prayers to break any soul ties is usually effective even if it has to be repeated. Here is a sample of how to pray to break such ties (from **Breaking the Power**):

*I want to be free from any emotional, intellectual, or self-willed ties I've let form, and I repent for allowing this to happen. Forgive me for finding satisfaction and fulfillment from someone other than my spouse and you, Lord. I loose, cut, and sever any and all soul-ties I have willingly or ignorantly entered into, rejecting the soulish satisfaction they have provided. I loose them, renouncing every wrong agreement I have ever come into that allowed them to be birthed in the first place. I will not seek emotional satisfaction from wrong sources.*

Soul ties often are often birthed from wrong agreements (verbally or mentally) made in response to unmet needs in your soul. When you have unmet needs in your soul, soul ties can begin to form from emotionally responding (even subtly) to attention from another person. The fact that you are beginning to feel uncomfortable means that unhealthy ties may be forming. If you don't have either of the above books, may I suggest downloading, printing out, reading, and praying from the e-book on my web site called **Keys to Understanding Soul Power, Soul Ties, and Soulsh Prayers** (just \$7). I think it might help you understand the danger of not breaking this possible soul tie. Other people

praying for you cannot break it. It must be broken and stopped by one who is involved in it. Liberty

QUESTION: I was attracted to a minister at my church, but he resigned and no longer attends. I am disappointed, hurting, and sad. How do I handle this? Lena

ANSWER: Lena, bind your will to God's will and earnestly thank Him for guiding you and protecting you from making any mistakes here. If God had wanted the relationship to go forth, He would have caused something to happen to let both of you know. God is not stymied when one or the other person in a potential relationship (that He has ordained) seems to walk out of our perceptions of His plans and purposes.

Thank God for His plans and purposes for your life and then bind your emotions to the healing balance of the Holy Spirit. Begin to loose (smash, crush, and destroy) all of the negative feelings you are having that are concerned with your sense of loss.

You can't really lose something you never had. I don't mean to sound uncaring, but I would hate for you to linger in a state of feeling a loss when it isn't. The truth is you probably didn't get something God didn't want you to have. However, if God has plans for you and this man, He will bring you across each others' paths again when you are both ready for His will. Arranged relationships are spectacular when God does the arranging! Liberty

Liberty: I am a remarried associate pastor from Dallas Texas. I have been offered a position with a church in Northern California. My wife does not want to go. Her father lives alone here and he has diabetes and Parkinson's Disease. My wife is an only child.

*This is very understandable for your wife to feel this way. She has a sense of duty to her family, which is a good thing. It does not seem to be out of line from what you have said here. This is part of the issues that come with blended marriages and elderly parents.*

Although my wife is a Christian, she continues to mention divorce as an option whenever we try to address our problems. She refuses to see a counselor. I have read your books and recently purchased your newest one. I have practiced binding and loosing prayers and taught on them.

*It does sound like you both should have an objective third party present when you talk about the struggles of your marriage. Perhaps she doesn't trust or like the counselor you have suggested. You say you have prayed the binding and loosing prayers. Using the Keys of the Kingdom in prayer works the most effectively when these principles become a way of life that allows you to*

*refocus and align with God and to strip off offenses, wrong patterns of thinking, and preconceived ideas.*

I do not want divorce, but she will not pray with me. She says that my prayers are much fancier than hers. *(Show her a simple passage from a basic binding and loosing prayers and ask her if she would pray that with you.)* I have allowed my fear of being twice divorced to make me incur significant debt emotionally and financially (\$53,000). I have been afraid of the impact that another divorce would have on my ability to minister.

*A second divorce could have a great impact on your ability to minister and counsel with other families. But any existing frustration and blame you're feeling about your marriage will also leak into your ministry to others. This is a hard thing, but I believe you should consider stepping away from ministering to others right now. You should find another way to support your family while you allow God to minister to you. Too many "leak" their own pain into their ministry to the body of Christ.*

*You need to let God help you work on your marriage, let Him help you work on your debts, and you need to believe that God has all the answers you need. Loose any preconceived ideas that you have about how everything should work out. When we are looking for something to work out the way we have predetermined it should, we often fail to see the answers God has for us. Your wife would be miserable and resentful if you try to force her to choose between moving or being there for her elderly father. I suggest that you press into praying the binding and loosing prayers, into the Word of God, and that you trust God to work with what your wife and you are facing. Your most important job right now is to be kind to her, to be as supportive as you can, to hold steady, and to try to get as close to Him as you can. He is waiting for surrender from you, not for you to figure out how to escape the issues complicating your life.*

Dorie and I both are licensed professional counselors. Your insight and applications regarding the human condition and spiritual warfare cuts right through the fluff and garbage. These prayer keys cut right to the core, one might even say, right to the razor’s edge between soul and spirit. We don’t know quite how to integrate all that we are learning from you into a professional practice or ministry. I am guessing that other Christians in the counseling professions have asked you about this.

I am now seeing that in spite of all my worldly wisdom, knowledge, and life experience just how very soulish I have been. I feel more humiliated than humbled by this realization, but the Lord is faithful and merciful and working on that, too. Your message and your teaching are as deep as the Spirit can take us, yet they are also basic, universally applicable, and doable while being radical in the best and most dangerous sense.

In any case, awakening to the power, subtlety, pitifulness, and antics of our own unsundered souls gives us a fresh perspective on other people’s poverty, rascalness, and preciousness. By the way, the chapter on Power Leadership in *The Unsundered Soul* packs just as much punch when substituting the word “counselor or therapist” for “leader.” Thank you, Liberty.
