#### A Word from Liberty

In reading Philippians 4:4-9 (*The Message*), I loved its translation of this Philippians passage.



#### Verse 4 **Celebrate God all day, every day. I mean, revel in him!**

What a great premise...celebrating God all day! The *Amplified Bible* says this means to gladden yourself in Him. This is meaningful, and I get really bugged when I forget it. Things happen, my soul gets sneaky, the enemy sends distractions, and I can find myself "so busy" that I neglect reading the Word. That's when I begin to notice little worries, vague anxiety and discouragement, times of waking up in the night and wondering why my mind is leaping around like a fish out of water.

When I come to my senses, I think, "I could have had a V-8 from God!" Just like the famous power juice we see on TV, God's Word strengthens us, gladdens us, and reminds us of the fact that we have so much to celebrate in Him! Then I drink my scriptural juice, and amazingly the little nagging thoughts and the night time jumping fish all melt away.

Verse 5 **Make it as clear as you can to all you meet that you're on their side, working with them and not against them. Help them see that the Master is about to arrive. He could show up any minute!**

This scriptural power juice is not to be hoarded for personal use only. It is to be shared fully, freely, and often, because there is a never-ending supply of it. Remember that there are many who need to know that God is for them and not against them. I get so many e-mails and letters from people who pour out their hearts to me, listing all of the hard things they are struggling with. As gently as I can, I remind them that the things they have just listed are not issues they have to figure out how to resolve. That's God's job and He loves doing it for them.

God already has answers just waiting to be delivered to them. We can get so miserable in hard times that we don't recognize that we are the ones who are blocking the delivery of these blessings. God is not falling down on the job of directing our heavenly UPS deliveries. If we could see more clearly in the Spirit, we would probably see all kinds of heavenly UPS yellow tags on our doors saying Delivery Attempted—Will Try Again Tomorrow. I try to get struggling Christians to focus on understanding that He really is for them and for their successful walk with Him. They don't have to solve the world's problems. They just need to use the Keys of the Kingdom prayer principles to force their souls to put things in God's hands while they cooperate with His will.

Verse 6 **Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns.**

Fretting is one of the most useless cycles your soul will ever run on you as it tries to worry worldly answers out of worldly clues. "I can't pay the rent—should I let the electrical bill go, should I let my tithes go, should I get a second job, should I try to borrow the money? Should I run away and join the circus?" God says don't fret! He knows all about your needs.

In the *Amplified Bible* (Luke 12:27-32), we are encouraged by these perfect instructions: Luke 12:27-32, "*Consider the lilies, how they grow. They neither [wearily] toil nor spin nor weave; yet I tell you...if God so clothes the grass in the field, which is alive today, and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, how much more will He clothe you...do not seek [by meditating and reasoning to inquire into] what you are to eat and what you are to drink; nor be of anxious (troubled) mind [unsettled,*

*excited, worried, and in suspense]... **Only aim at and strive for and seek His kingdom, and all these things shall be supplied to you also. Do not be seized with alarm and struck with fear, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom!***"

Don't just bite your lower lip, frown, and try to make your soul stop its fretting. Trying to stop its fretting in the natural can be like trying to stop your lungs from breathing. You just can't do it on your own sometimes. You need to distract your mind with the second part of verse 6. This part tells us if we turn our thoughts to praying and then praising God for the answers that are going to come, our worries are reshaped into prayers.

The best prayers for this type of "reshaping" are prayers of agreeing with God's faithfulness to you, agreeing with His love for you, and agreeing with His unlimited power to meet all your needs. Wailing prayers that recite more lists of your fears and lack only keep pointing you back to the things you are fretting over. These are not the best prayers to get breakthrough. As hard as it is for the human mind to wrap itself around this truth, God is NOT always moved by the intensity of your emotional distress. He is moved by your belief in the face of all odds that He can work it out and that He will work it out for you.

The last part of verse 6 says that when you are praying this way, you are letting God know your concerns. Surprise! God already knows all of your concerns. However, He also knows that humans have a need to make sure of that. I believe He does not mind if we reiterate our situations a bit in our prayers like this:

*God, my wife and I are discouraged and feeling hopeless because of our teenagers' bad attitudes and wrong actions. But I am so grateful that you can work in them when they are beyond our view and our help. I know that you can draw them to yourself in your own way, and I know that you love them more than we ever will.*

*So, I'm praising you and thanking you for what you are doing and what you are going to do. I bind them and I bind us to your will, and I loose all of the world's influences, their peers' influences, and the works of the enemy from them.*

*Show me and my wife where to step in and when to step out of your way. We trust you to do so and we will rest in this. When fretting surfaces in our souls again, we will go back over your Word and this prayer to remind ourselves of our part. Amen!*

**Verse 7 Before you know it, a sense of God's wholeness, everything coming together for good, will come and settle you down. It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the center of your life.**

Well, praise God! We just walked through how to practice His Word. If we do it, just like we have practiced understanding it here, we can expect His wholeness and peace to begin settling our souls down. We can know that we know that things are coming together for good.

**Verse 8 Summing it all up, friends, I'd say you'll do best by filling your minds and meditating on things true, noble, reputable, authentic, compelling, gracious—the best, not the worst; the beautiful, not the ugly; things to praise, not things to curse.**

Here we come to the final instructions (the summing up) of how to hold onto His presence and His peace in the midst of our storms. We fill our minds and our thoughts with things true, noble, reputable, authentic, compelling, gracious, best, beautiful, and praiseworthy. We find all of that in His Word, His supernaturally-empowered Word that will drive out fear, doubt, ugliness, and anger. Filling our minds with good things establishes the focus of our thinking, giving no room for bad thoughts to creep back in and flourish. Isn't God good!

Many great thanks to Paula and Pastor Bryan Pierce for all their help in putting together these meetings. The meetings were a wonder, indeed, and one wonder was very unusual. Paula and I had lunch in a restaurant the day after I arrived in Florida, a restaurant that was far out in the bay. We had to walk about 100 yards out on a dock to get to it. While sitting and enjoy our lobster bisque, I began to notice that the restaurant was moving. Coming from California, when the building you are in begins to move, you get out because it means earthquake!

I expressed this to Paula and she laughed, “That’s just because we’re so far out in the water. The waves move the restaurant. We don’t have earthquakes in Florida, Liberty!” Later, after teaching Friday night and all day Saturday, I stayed home Sunday morning to pray, and prepare for a church service that night. All of a sudden my top floor condo began to shake. My chair began to shake and leaves began falling off a shaking silk ficus tree.

Behind these lovely condos, there is a beautiful boat canal filled with boats and manatees—big, gentle, slow moving aquatic creatures. Manatees can be 10-12 feet long and up to 1,800 pounds. Knowing that there is always great distress in the animal world when there is an earthquake, I looked and saw huge bubbles surfacing all over the canal—a sure sign of manatee distress! I called Paula and told her what was happening and she laughed and said, “Liberty, we don’t have earthquakes in Florida. It’s probably blasting on the bridge or a jet going over.”

“Well, then I think you need to come up with a new name for this particular shaking because this wasn’t bridge blasting or a jet plane,” I said.

About two hours later, Paula called me back and said, “Ummm, Liberty? We just turned on the television and guess what? There was a 6.5 magnitude earthquake in the Gulf of Mexico about 240 miles from here, and we felt it here in St. Petersburg. How strange. **A Prophetic Word to the Body**

I was sent a prophetic word given by Teresa Seputis ([ts@godsspeak.org](mailto:ts@godsspeak.org)) which I have excerpted here:

**Questions and Answers by Liberty**

**QUESTION:** It’s just too much hard work trying to receive healing and deliverance; it just takes so much energy. The page 30 prayer in *Breaking the Power* is helpful, but I wonder when will I truly be emotionally healed? I have little interest if any for others and their problems. I’ve gotten lost over the last **three years**. When are these prayers going to heal me? Sam

Sam: These prayers won’t heal you. When you pray the binding and loosing prayers, you are breaking through layers of deception, old patterns of thinking, and wrong beliefs to expose your soul’s hidden wounds so that God can heal you. These prayers don’t require a lot of energy, just belief that somehow they are going to break through your soul’s stronghold walls for you. What are you thinking or doing that is requiring so much energy? The prayers also require persistence. Reading the Word requires persistence. You are not effecting your own healing by your prayer activity (which really would be a

lot of work). These prayers help you cooperate with His divine help and healing. Stop working so hard at trying to get healed. Relax in His love and use His keys to make sure you are cooperating with Him. I've attached a copy here of our newest laminated prayer. I think it might help you rearrange some of your wrong thinking. Liberty

QUESTION: I believe that God gave a man to me as a blessing. I was advised by a lady who did my deliverance that I "cannot" accept this man as a blessing from God. I believe that if it's God's will, we will be together; but at this moment it doesn't seem to be happening. What am I doing wrong? Marianne

Marianne: Based upon your own soul's state of surrender to God's will and whatever unmet needs and unhealed hurts you have (we all have some), whether or not you are doing "something wrong" is the wrong question. What you can do that is right is bind your will to God's will, bind your mind to the mind of Christ, and bind your emotions to the healing balance of the Holy Spirit. Loose, smash, crush and destroy all of your preconceived ideas, misconceptions, and wrong beliefs that you may have about God's plan for your life. Loose the effects and influences of wrong agreements you have made and loose the interference of the enemy in your life. Pray the same prayer for the man.

It doesn't matter what some other person advises you or what you believe regarding this man and God's will for your life. There are so many variables in your own soul, your own unresolved issues, and your own needs that you can only be grateful to turn this all over to God and allow Him to take the necessary steps to show you what He is doing for you. If this man is to be a blessing to you, God will see that a relationship happens as long as you don't try to push it to happen or try to manipulate it into happening. God is the Master of prearranged relationships for His children. Cooperate with Him by staying close to Him and staying out of the way of what He is doing. He will clearly show you when to walk forward or to wait or to turn away. In the meantime, get on with whatever ministry or fellowship opportunities He opens up for you right now. God bless, Liberty

Dear Liberty: My name is Francine and I live in Europe. I was raised in a Christian family but my faith has been very superficial until 4 years ago after reading your book *Shattering Your Strongholds*. Now I feel strong ties with God, and He helped me to overcome some bad illnesses and years-long depressions. I am 39 years old and divorced twice (ex-husbands are now living in other relationships). I am longing so much for a new relationship after years of loneliness, but I know that 1 Corinthians 7:11 says that a divorced woman shall stay without marriage or return to her man (which is not possible or likely). So do I have to bury all my hopes for a relationship for the rest of my life?

As I understand God's Word, He does not allow sexual life before or outside of marriage. I think it is impossible to know a man at my age (39) and expect him to marry me before having any sexual contact. Since I have found my faith and ties to God, these questions torture me as I am longing for a complete relationship with a man. My pastor told me that God would agree to a sexual relationship even without marriage if both partners want it (and are obviously free). But my doubts and concerns don't stop. Can you please help me to get some light in this issue? Thank you for all your prayers that have helped me so much to overcome many of my problems while guiding me to God. God bless you, Francine

You do not have to bury your hopes at all, but you do need to reach a place where you want the will of God so much that it doesn't matter to you whether or not He brings a man into your life. That might sound hard, but it will be your proof that you have allowed God to so meet your unmet needs and unhealed hurts that you are ready to be a pure blessing to someone else. This is a good test of being ready for a relationship in that you want God's will more than any relationship you think you need to feel better about your life.

Francine, God does not want any of His children to have sexual relations outside of marriage—that is truth, point blank, absolute truth! The reasons are multiple, not the least being that marriage was not only designed for procreation, it was also designed for the emotional and mental commitment and protection that God wants you to have in a relationship. God can help you obey His commands and keep you protected until He brings you to a safe and pure and wonderful relationship. If God has a relationship for you, know that it will be a perfect one! It won't matter if you are 29 or 69; God will always have both people in a relationship that He has ordained to be completely right and completely prepared for each other in His perfect timing.

I'm sure that you don't want a third divorce or failed intimate relationship to tear up your life. Anyone who seeks companionship based on his/her natural feelings and thoughts and soulish needs will never make the best choices in relationships without direction from God. Even non-believers who have good relationships have had some guidance from God because of their future with Him. Normally I would never question or criticize someone's pastor's advice, but if your pastor said to you exactly

what you have indicated above, he is wrong, wrong, wrong. I prayed for you today. Liberty Savard

Lynette: Situations like yours are often pre-destiny opportunities surfacing to polish up some areas in your life that you have managed to keep shoving to the back of the closet. I am glad that you have been reading *The Unsundered Soul*. If you will earnestly pray the prayers in this book, you will begin to see some glimmers of hope and breakthrough on the horizon. Instead of focusing on your situation, which I know is a hard place to be right now, focus on the fact that God has already called you into the ministry and He has plans for you. You're just still in some final preparation for that calling.

If the man you have been investing your emotions in is not interested in marriage, praise God that he has declared this. You don't need to be in a relationship that you have more hopes for than he does. If this was the man for you, God would have him expressing at least some kind of understanding and hope for your future together. I strongly suggest that you put your expectations of others on the shelf right now, and that you focus on praying the binding and loosing prayers and reading the Word. God knows all of the answers that you don't have right now. Pray and read the Word to help you to relax and stop trying to dig the answers out for yourself. That's God's job. There are many things right now that you can't change except how you are responding to your situations, and you appear to be responding from a victim mentality. Please keep praying the prayers in *Shattering Your Strongholds* for yourself. You really need to focus on you right now because there is no peace in your soul and your emotions are pretty ragged. You can't be a blessing to anyone else and you can't change anything going on in your family until you can get some peace and healing into your own soul. Keep reading the Word, particularly in *The Message*, for some healing and cleansing of your emotions and your thoughts.

God loves you and He knows where you are and what is happening, so please stop thinking He doesn't care. He cares very much. But God does allow difficult things to remain unresolved in our lives when we are not where we should be in our thinking and our feelings. It's like your answers and blessings are being sent to the Point B, where you are supposed to be while you're squatting down in the dirt at Point A complaining about why your answers aren't coming.
